Bank Website Refresh Now Live


If you haven't visited www.westplainsbank.com recently, you may notice a refreshed look.

What is REAL ID?

"REAL ID" comes from the REAL ID Act of 2005, a federal law focused on fraud protection, anti-terrorism, and driver's license and nondriver's license identification card (ID card) security.

Beginning May 7, 2025, every air traveler 18 years of age and older will be required to present a REAL ID-compliant driver license or ID card, or another form of ID accepted by the Transportation Security Administration, to board federally regulated domestic flights.

DO I NEED ONE?

YES if: Flying domestically Accessing federal facilities, military bases and federal courthouses Entering nuclear power plants NO: Driving Voting or registering to vote State Purposes Age Verification You hold another form of identifica-

tion that meets federal requirements, such as a valid U.S passport or passport card.

HOW TO APPLY—

You can apply for a REAL ID-compliant driver license or nondriver ID card at any Missouri license office location. You will be required to submit valid, original documents from each of the categories below at the time you apply:

- Identity (i.e. Birth Certificate, Passport)
- Lawful Status
- Social Security Number
- Proof of Missouri Residency (2

documents from different sources required i.e. utility bill, voter registration, bank statement)

• Name Change Document

A full, interactive list of Real ID acceptable documents and more information about REAL ID is available at dor.mo.gov/driver-license/issuance/real-id/

The cost of obtaining a REAL ID-compliant driver License or nondriver ID card is the same as for a license or ID card that is noncompliant with REAL ID.

Your Missouri REAL ID-compliant driver licenses and nondriver ID cards will have a star in the upper righthand corner.
